On or before June 1, 2015 compliance deadlines in the U.S. and EU, Carboline will be complying with GHS, which is an acronym for the Globally Harmonized System of Classification and Labeling of Chemicals. GHS is a government driven program to standardize and harmonize the classification and labeling of chemicals, thereby providing consistent hazard communication worldwide. This standard will require all chemical substances (including coatings) to be labeled with consistent warning symbols and phrases, regardless of where the product is manufactured. The formulation of our products as well as the application and handling instructions are unchanged. The classification, labeling and notification regulations have changed. The differences that you will see on our product labels and Safety Data Sheets are a result of Carboline staying in compliance with this new global standard.
